# **Building Fall Example:**

Uncontrolled cradling, dismounting or lowering a building skill (not timing issues)

Base or spotter falling to the floor during a cradle or dismount.

#### **Athlete Fall Example:**

Hands down in tumbling or jumps.

Knees down in tumbling or jumps.

Drops to the floor during individual skills (tumbling, jumps etc.)

## Major Building Fall Example:

Falls from individual stunt, pyramid, or tosses to the floor (top person lands on floor or multiple bases/spotters land on floor).

#### **Maximum Deduction Example:**

When multiple deductions should be assessed during an individual stunt or toss (by a single group), or during a pyramid collapse, the sum of those deductions will not be greater than 1.75.

\*\*\*Bobbles, balance checks and controlled timing errors will be reflected in technique scores.

# **Time Limit Violations:**

Routine time limit is 2:30 for Allstar. Two minutes for Prep divisions.

# **Safety Violation Example:**

Out of level skills.

#### **Boundary Violations Example:**

Stepping outside the 42' X 54' competition floor with both feet.

## **Unsportsmanlike Conduct Deduction:**

When a coach is in discussion with an official, other coach, athlete or parent/spectator they must maintain proper professional conduct. Failing to do so WILL result in a 4.0 deduction, removal of the coach or disqualification.
